

Mr Hately commenced his career at Canberra Grammar School in 1991 where he rose to the position of Head of Department and was part of the Elite Athlete Education team at the Australian Institute of Sport. In 1994 he was appointed Adjunct Professor at the University of West Virginia where he established an international teacher training exchange program before being appointed Director of Pastoral and Residential Care at the Snowy Mountains Grammar School in 1999.

In 2003 Mr Hately was appointed to the staff of St Peter's College where he held various roles including Head of House, Residential Master and Teacher in Charge of Football before being appointed Head of Senior School in 2006.

Mr Hately has been widely published in the Educational literature and graduated as a Fellow of the Governor's Leadership Foundation in 2007.
