## Foundation Performing Arts Scholarship

### Introduction

The Trinity College Foundation offers a Performing Arts Scholarship every 2<sup>nd</sup> year to support the College's Whole School Musical/Production. The scholarship exists to foster diversity by ensuring that an education at Trinity College is available to as wide a range of students as possible. Our scholarship seeks to support students who will contribute to the richness and diversity of the College's community through the Performing Arts.

### Criteria

Applicants must be enrolled at Trinity College at the time of application.

The scholarship is open to internal students Years 9-12 only.

The scholarship is awarded to a student who is in the College Musical and has talents in aspects of performing arts and who is prepared to show leadership and commitment in the Trinity production.

The applicant must be able to substantiate talent and skills in the area of Performing Arts and have the confidence of the College staff involved in the major production.

### Process

Applications **must be received** by **21 February 2012**.

Short listed applicants will be notified and shall be interviewed by a panel which comprises of Foundation Board and a member of the Arts Faculty.

The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Foundation Board. No award shall be made if, in the opinion of the Foundation Board, no candidate is of sufficient merit.

An audition may be requested at interview time. Short listed candidates will be notified of this requirement.

### Award

The scholarship will entitle the successful applicant/s up to \$1,500, to be used to further develop skills in the performing arts.

More than one scholarship can be awarded.

### Expectations

The successful applicants will undertake an active role in the major production under the direction of College staff and be required to speak at a Foundation meeting following the major production with a summary of their role in the production. The successful applicants will be photographed and acknowledged in the College publications and on the website.
