Key Summer Uniform Issues



Males

HAIR

Requirement	Consequence If Requirement Not Met
Neat hairstyles no longer than the collar	Parent notified in <i>diary</i> ; Sent to Dean of students; Time frame set for getting hair cut (no later than end of same week)
No extreme hairstyles and no hair dyes (the hair must be an all over natural colour)	Student sent home following parent contact; to return once haircut has been modified or colour has been returned to natural colour

HATS

Requirement	Consequence If Requirement Not Met
Hats compulsory during Terms 1 & 4 and when the UV metre reading is above 3 ; to be worn during recess and lunch when exposed to sunlight	Uniform Infringement Sticker Student required to move to the Hat Room if hat is not at school; If student has three notes regarding non-wearing of hat, sent to Dean of Students
Regulation cloth hat to be neat, with no writing evident; Hat brim must be intact	Parent notified in <i>diary</i> ; Sent to Dean of Students ; Time frame set for purchasing new hat (no later than end of same week)

JEWELLERY

Requirement	Consequence If Requirement Not Met
No Jewellery except a watch.	Item confiscated for the duration of the week; Note into diary; If worn again, parent to collect item from North Front Office
A crucifix/cross (of no more than 20mm) may be worn; permission must be sought, in writing, from a Dean of Students	Item confiscated for the duration of the week; Uniform Infringement Sticker If worn again, parent to collect item from North Front Office

WEARING of SHIRTS

Requirement	Consequence If Requirement Not Met
Shirts must be worn tucked in	Uniform Infringement Sticker If student has three Stickers regarding shirt being untucked, sent to Dean of Students
A long shirt must be worn with a tie	Uniform Infringement Sticker If noted on three separate days , sent to Dean of Students
A shirt without a Trinity Logo must be worn with a tie	Uniform Infringement Sticker If noted on three separate days , sent to Dean of Students

HAIR

Requirement	Consequence If Requirement Not Met
Neat hairstyles no longer than the bottom of the collar ; Long hair to be tied back in a neat fashion	Parent notified in diary ; If student has three notes regarding not having hair tied back, sent to Dean of Students
No extreme hairstyles and no hair dyes (the hair must be an all over natural colour)	Student sent home following parent contact; to return once haircut has been modified or colour has been returned to natural colour
Hair ties, ribbons, scrunchies, headbands in red or dark blue , or school fabric	Note written in diary ; If noted on three separate days, sent to Dean of Students

HATS

Requirement	Consequence If Requirement Not Met
Hats compulsory during Terms 1 & 4 and when the UV metre reading is above 3 ; to be worn during recess and lunch when exposed to sunlight	Uniform Infringement Sticker Student required to move to the Hat Room if hat is not at school; If student has three notes regarding non-wearing of hat, sent to Dean of Students
Regulation cloth hat to be neat, with no writing evident; Hat brim must be intact	Parent notified in diary ; Sent to Dean of Students ; Time frame set for purchasing new hat (no later than end of same week)

JEWELLERY

Requirement	Consequence If Requirement Not Met
No Jewellery except a watch ; One pair of gold or silver ball stud earrings worn in the lowest holes in the lobe of an ear; A doctor's certificate (new each year) is required to wear sleepers [note presented to Dean of Students]	Item(s) confiscated for the duration of the week; Uniform Infringement Sticker If worn again, parent to collect item(s) from North Front Office
A crucifix/cross (of no more than 20mm) may be worn; permission must be sought, in writing, from a Dean of Students	Item confiscated for the duration of the week; Uniform Infringement Sticker If worn again, parent to collect item from North Front Office

MAKEUP/NAIL POLISH

Requirement	Consequence If Requirement Not Met
No makeup or nail polish is to be worn whilst students are in school uniform	Uniform Infringement Sticker Student will be required to remove makeup/nail polish immediately ; If noted on three separate days, sent to Dean of Students

Every two Uniform Infringement Stickers result in a Lunch Yard Duty
