Trinity College Hockey Pitch – Terms of Use

Access

Access to the College and the pitch is via either Greening Drive or Greenslade Boulevard. Please see map below.

Parking

Please park in either the South carpark or the South Staff carpark to access the pitch or sometimes the South Oval if the game is on grass.

Security

Please do not go outside the area marked with the red line on the Map. Definitely no access to the dam area.



Use of the Pitch

As the pitch is new this will be a developing area. A representative(s) of each using organisation will be issued with a swipe badge to open the facilities and change rooms. They will be instructed on use of the pitch, lights, irrigation and scoreboard as necessary. They will be required to make sure the Pitch Guidelines are followed:

Pitch Guidelines

- 1. All players and officials are to enter the pitch through the gate at halfway.
- 2. Players / officials are not to jump fences to retrieve balls during game play.
- 3. Training should be conducted across the pitch to prevent wear to the goal circles.
- 4. Players and officials may use running shoes or turf shoes. No spikes or studs.
- 5. Goals need two people, one on each blue pole at the rear to move them.
- 6. Goals are to be returned to the 4 training circles at the end of training.
- 7. Food is not to be consumed on the pitch.
- 8. No glass permitted in and around the pitch.
- 9. Blood on the surface is to be washed with a large volume of water.
- 10. Balls should not be deliberately hit into fences, signs or the scoreboard.
- 11. Spectators are not permitted on the pitch and must remain behind the fences.
- 12. Balls and equipment belonging to the College are not to be removed from the facility.

Rubbish

The Hirer has to ensure that all rubbish is placed in the bins provided.

Smoking Policy

Trinity College is a no smoking area. People wishing to smoke are asked to leave the grounds to do so. Nearest exit is at Greenslade Boulevard.

Alcohol Management Policy

The only place that alcohol may be purchased and consumed is within the licensed area of the Trinity College Pavilion. The user and the College will work closely together with regard to Pavilion arrangements. Under the conditions of the Special Circumstances Licence it is not permissible to consume alcohol other than in the Pavilion. The user will need to ensure that alcohol is not consumed other than in the licensed area.

Non compliance

People not complying with the Terms of Use will be asked to leave the Pitch area.
