### SACE Results 2013

Trinity College wishes to congratulate all Year 12 students on their results for 2013:

- The top 4 students achieved an ATAR above 99, placing them in the top 1% of the state.
- 10 students received an ATAR above 98, placing them in the top 2% of the state.
- 33 students received an ATAR above 90, placing them in the top 10% of the state.
- 252 'A' grades were achieved, 30 more than in 2012.
- 258 students achieved their SACE.
