#### **Trinity College SACE Results 2015**

Trinity College wishes to congratulate all Year 12 students on their results for 2015, 281 students achieved their SACE.

- The top 9 students achieved an ATAR above 98, placing them in the top 2% of Australia.
- 56 students received an ATAR above 90, placing them in the top 10% of Australia, this is comfortably the highest number in the history of the College.
- 258 'A' grades were achieved.
- The median ATAR was 81, another College record.
