Through the generosity of supporters of the Trinity College Foundation and fundraising activities, we are pleased to support the Trinity2Cambodia service trip by way of an award. The award exists to acknowledge a student who is striving to help others and willingly volunteers to support College life.

The Trinity2Cambodia Service Award will create an opportunity for a Trinity student to contribute to the richness and diversity of the College's community through learning about Non Government Organisations (NGOs) abroad, performing volunteer work in Cambodia, developing new strategies to help others in need and their ability to strengthen community relationships.

Criteria

- Applicants must be enrolled at Trinity College at the time of application.
- The award is open to internal students in Years 10 to 11 only.
- The award is for a student who is wishing to participate in the Trinity2Cambodia overseas trip and may not afford all of the travel costs.
- The applicant must be able to substantiate their volunteer work within the community, including duties undertaken at the College as a volunteer.
- The Director of Finance will review an applicant's current school fee accounts.

Process

- Applications must be received by Friday 14 February 2020.
- A short listing process may occur dependent upon the number of applications received.
- The award will be given at the discretion of the Head of the College. No award shall be made if, in the opinion of the Head of the College, no candidate is of sufficient merit.
- Short listed applicants may be interviewed by a panel.
- Successful applicants are still responsible for fundraising commitments for the Trinity2Cambodia program and all other travel costs, including immunisations and passport.

Award

• The award will entitle the successful applicant/s up to \$1,500 to be used towards their travel expenses to participate in the service trip. More than one award can be granted.

Expectations

- The successful applicant/s may be required to speak at a Foundation gathering or attend a Foundation event to assist with fundraising activities.
- The successful applicant/s may be photographed and acknowledged in the College publications and on the website.
