
2024 Open Day for Old Scholars

Thursday 4 April

4pm to 6pm Visit Blakeview, Gawler River or Roseworthy Schools

Gawler River and Blakeview schools will have all classrooms open for you to explore, with student performances, stalls to support charities, food and drink to purchase and a number of hands on activities/displays. At our new Roseworthy School there will be an official opening ceremony from 4pm in the hall. After this event, guests are free to roam the school to visit classrooms, the library, playgrounds and the Early Learning Centre.

Sunday 7 April

11am to 12pm Hewitson Theatre, STARplex

A Whole College Service will be held in the Hewitson Theatre for current students, parents and staff to acknowledge the 40th birthday of the College. The service will include the dedication of plaques for newly named buildings and a special birthday performance. Old Scholars are welcome to join us with additional seating organised on the Courts in STARplex with the service being projected onto screens for easy viewing.

12pm to 2pm Visit North, South & Senior Schools

Old Scholars are free to roam the College with access to our schools plus the Marnkutyi Parirna Theatre, the College Chapel, the Trinity Innovation & Creativity School, Trade Training Centre, the farm, Roma Waite Library, the Big Shed and Montessori.

- Girls Football will be on the Waldeck Oval, Netball on the South Courts and mixed Hockey on the synthetic pitch.
- View the INCOGNITO Art Show in the Gallery at TICS which includes Old Scholars art work.
- There is an Archives display with Richard Bednall Sporting albums, old school uniforms and many large school group photographs in the Roma Waite Library.
- Musical performances will be on rotation in the Marnkutyi Parirna Theatre from 12:15pm including rehearsals for Mamma Mia the Musical.
- Visit TICS for all things STEM related including the laser cutter, Virtual Reality tools and robotics.
- Try some College wine and meet the animals in the farm. Food vans will operate across the College.
