

Minimum BYOD Device Requirements 2023 Guideline

The College's Wi-Fi network operates on the 802.11ac 5 GHz standard. **Devices that do not support this standard as a minimum will not be able to connect.**

Requirement	Check List
Support for the 802.11ac (Wi-Fi 5) as minimum, 802.11ax (Wi-Fi 6) is preferred	
The current version of either Microsoft Windows or macOS (No support for Windows 10 S, iOS (e.g. iPad) or Android (e.g. Chromebooks))	
Minimum 2Ghz processor	
Minimum 8Gb installed RAM	
Minimum 128Gb local storage	
Minimum 8-hour battery life	
Minimum 11" screen (13" Recommended)	
Keyboard*	
Camera	
Microphone	
A carry case or skin to protect the device	
3-year warranty (manufacturer or extended aftermarket retail option) **	
Insurance (with Accidental Damage)**	

Other considerations

- **Casing:** Tough and sturdy to avoid breakage.
- **Weight:** Lightweight for ease of carrying.
- **Durability:** Durable and strong.
- **Charging Brick:** An optional accessory to provide additional battery life.

* Extra care will need to be taken with devices that are paired with a detachable keyboard. Consider purchasing a device with a physically connected keyboard such as a laptop computer.

* * Insurance and warranty: Be aware of the terms of insurance policies/warranties for the device. The College will not accept responsibility for loss or breakage.

NB: The College will provide students with a copy of Microsoft Office to be installed on the device. Students have the option to install a copy of the Adobe Creative Cloud applications where the device meets Adobe's minimum requirements for the software.
